

Cape Charles Production Wells  
Drilling, Pump Installation, Testing

The Town of Cape Charles is accepting bids for drilling two new production wells on property located inside the Town limits. Included in the scope of work is drilling two wells, installation of the pumps associated with the two wells and all testing required by the DEQ and VDH to bring the wells on line. Bid packages are available from the Town Clerk whose office is located upstairs in the Town Hall, 2 Plum Street, Cape Charles from the hours of 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. No deposit is required. A pre-bid meeting will be held in the Town Hall conference room on June 9 at 2 p.m. All bids will be due in by 2 p.m. June 14, 2010, bids will be opened at that time.

This project will be partially funded by the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 (ARRA). The ARRA specifies several requirements that localities must comply with, such as the use of only American made steel, iron, and manufactured goods in the project, payment of Davis-Bacon Act Wages, and solicitation of Disadvantaged Business Enterprises.
