At approximately 7:00 p.m. Mayor Dora Sullivan called to order the Public Hearing of the Town Council. In addition to Mayor Sullivan, present were Councilmen Bannon, Bennett, Burdiss, Elliott, Evans and Veber. Also in attendance were Town Manager Heather Arcos, Town Planner Tom Bonadeo, Town Treasurer Jo Anna Leatherwood and Town Clerk Libby Hume.

Mayor Sullivan announced the evening's public hearing was to hear public comment on the proposed modification to Section 3.2 – Single Family Residential District R-1 of the Cape Charles Zoning Ordinance, the issuance of the general obligation public improvement bonds in the estimated maximum amount of \$2,700,000 to finance the cost of infrastructure and economic development projects, and the amendment of the public improvement note financing the costs of constructing or acquiring certain public facilities not to exceed \$8,060,000 of a general obligation note issued under a pooled financing program administered by VML/VACo and its affiliates.

There were no public comments to be heard and no written comments were submitted prior to the hearing regarding any of the issues included in this public hearing.
