At 7:05 p.m. Mayor Dora Sullivan called to order the Public Hearing of the Town Council. In addition to Mayor Sullivan, present were Councilmen Bannon, Bennett, Burdiss and Elliott. Councilmen Evans and Veber were not in attendance. Also in attendance were Town Manager Heather Arcos, Town Planner Tom Bonadeo and Town Clerk Libby Hume.
